

I just want to take this opportunity to thank all of you again for your continued patronage of our dinning program. We love being able to serve all of you each and every day. As the Culinary Manager I am always looking for ways to enhance our resident's satisfaction of our culinary offerings. Over the past year we have successfully implemented the "Lighter Side Menu" delighting our residents with healthier menu option to compete alongside your some of your favorite menu choices.



If you're not quite feeling like the two options we our having for either lunch or supper peak your culinary interests, the bistro menu is available for you to use. I would like to take this opportunity to explain how pre-ordering from this menu is extremely helpful for our culinary staff. If you preorder your selection, this helps us prepare the order in a timely manner, starting to cook the selection when you arrive in the dining room.

During lunch service there are two chefs producing meals, in a combined effort, and depending on the amount of bistro orders we are producing at a given time, we can usually ensure that your order will be carefully prepared in a timely manner. At supper service however, there is only one chef, so preordering for this meal service is essential for timely orders. I also would like all to remind all of you that there are 18-21 residents that eat in their rooms or in the assisted dining room each meal, and quite often we are busy preparing and producing their meals as well as the meals in the independent dining room at the same time. Please help us by pre-ordering all bistro orders for the supper service. You can preorder by either stopping by the bistro and informing us of your selection, or by calling the main kitchen number 763-270-3487 to place your order with one of our staff, or leaving a voicemail for us.

I will be making a new Bistro menu for the entire year, opting for an annual update rather than a seasonal update to this menu. I encourage all of you to contact me if you would like to make suggestions for the upcoming menu change as I always appreciate your input as this is your menu to enjoy for lunch or supper. My goal is to have the new 2023 Bistro menu available by January 1st of 2023.
